ANNOUNCEMENTS/REMINDERS

This week we are learning:

READING NOVEL UNITS:

Boxcar Children: We work on "swoop-swoop" reading for smoothness & fluency. Students illustrate and write about key events from chapter 3.

Mr. Poppers Penguins: We work on cause and effect and take a short assessment on chapters 1-5.

READING LOGS: Students should read 20 minutes a night and be marking the October log. Students should be reading at least ONE fiction chapter book this month.

LANGUAGE ARTS: We go outside and make observations about what we see, hear and feel. We then use these observations to write a fall poem. We focus on using juicy adjectives.

MATH: We take a subtraction assessment. We also begin chapter 4 on multiplication. This week we focus on multiplication as groups of and repeated addition.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We continue our study of geography. This week we learn about the different bodies of water.

SCIENCE: We begin our unit on inherited traits and learned behaviors.

RELIGION: This week, we get to attend Mass in-person. We learn more about the Mysteries of the Rosary and practice the "Come Holy Spirit" prayer. **Please make sure your third grader is practicing at home. They will be tested the week of November 8th.**
