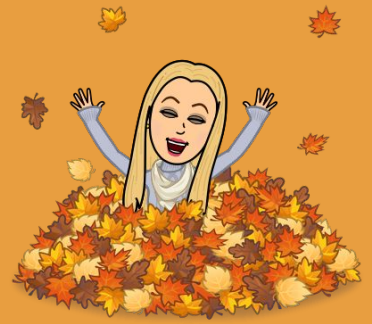

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING:

READING: Students will read chapters 6-8 in the Boxcar Children. Our target skills are: character traits and cause/effect. Children should be reading at least 20 min per night and marking off their Nov. calendar. Please try to have kids reading from paper books (not digital) as much as possible! Their eyes need a break from the screen.

LANGUAGE ARTS: We will work on combining sentences and constructing compound sentences.

MATH: We continue our study of multiplication. This week we make array cities.

SCIENCE: We learn about weather and climate in the "Stormy Skies" unit from Mystery Science.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We review the pacific region states and learn a new section of states in our GeoJourney.

RELIGION: We begin Ch. 5--this chapter explains how we worship as Catholics and the special place of the Eucharist among the Seven Sacraments. Students also create greeting cards as a part of a service project in conjunction with the HRS St. Vincent de Paul Society.
